The T-130 and T-140 earned an outstanding reputation among riders and reviewers alike, becoming two of the most successful trail bikes Whyte ever produced.

Instead of making small incremental changes, Whyte took everything they had learned over years of developing award-winning mountain bikes and applied it to a completely new frame and suspension platform.
